#### **Old Business**

Discussion of 28E Agreements and Legislation HF 2643.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that in accordance with recent legislation, when a county leaves the Region, the cash flow amount to be disturbed to the county shall be based on the population but does not include funds saved for emergencies.

Motion by VandeHoef and seconded by Jensvold to identify the Fund Balance as the Emergency Fund. Unanimously approved.

Motion by Merrill and seconded by Loss to authorize the acquisition of a Regional credit card and update the credit card policy. Unanimously approved.

Update on the CARES Funds distribution process was distributed to board members.

Update on the CARES Funds Regional Initiative and discussion of possible name change.

Motion by Merrill and seconded by VandeHoef to discontinue collection of crisis service payments and implement the practice of issuing a welcome letter and offering service coordination to those in crisis.

#### **New Business**

Motion by VandeHoef and seconded by Jensvold for an Exception to Policy to pay \$1,391.00 for an emergency rent payment. Unanimously approved.

Motion by Merrill and seconded by Jensvold to set Attorney fees at a max of \$65.00/hour for a max of 3 hours for committal fees. Unanimously approved.

A consensus of the Board was to continue with the Regional policy to not pay for Children's commitment fees. This will be reviewed during the upcoming budget process.

No action was taken on Berryhill Mobile Crisis in Kossuth County at this time. This will be reviewed at the December meeting.

No action was taken on the Hancock County Letter of Intent to join this Region. More information is needed.

## **Updates**

Updates were given by service providers regarding regional services, which included an update on Assertive Community Treatment (ACT), Individualized Placements and Supports (IPS) which saw no new referrals, 3 active cases and 3 individuals currently employed and an update by Fear with Spencer Hospital.

### **Public Comment**

There was no public comment.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Stone and seconded by Loss. The motion was unanimously passed. Meeting was adjourned at 4:05 pm.

The next meeting will be held November 24 at 1:30 at the Shores in Emmetsburg and via Zoom.
