Exception to Policy-Horizons Unlimited – Motion by Stone and seconded by Nath to approve the exception to policy to pay \$883.99 for maintenance fees and deny the forgiveness of the \$3,301.88 repayment amount. The motion was unanimously approved.

Life Connections Contract – BHIS Services – Motion by Vande Hoef and seconded by Merrill to approve the contract with Life Connections-BHIS services for FY24. The motion was unanimously approved.

Service Coordination Update – Jenn Dykshoorn – Dykshoorn shared with the board that with the uncertainty of changes being made by the state, we will be putting the hiring of a Service Coordinator on hold. Duties will be split between current staff.

Financial Projection Update & Appropriation withholding finalization amounts – Motion by Merrill and seconded by Schmidt to approve a budget amendment to increase the FY24 budget to \$3,201,213. The motion was unanimously approved.

Regional Staffing – Planning and FY25 Salary Adjustments – Motion by Stone and seconded by Schmidt to approve a 4% salary adjustment for FY25. The motion was unanimously approved.

Health and Human Services HMA Report – Loehr shared with the board the realignment plans of the State to consolidate Regions to an ASO (Administrative System Organization) that will oversee MHDS Regional Funds, Tobacco Funds, and Gambling Funds. Governing Boards will no longer exist, but the ASO would require an advisory board.

There was no Public Comment.

The next meeting is scheduled for February 27, 2024, at 1:30 at the Shores in Emmetsburg.
